

From this small private island lost in the Indian Ocean emerges the strength of an intangible location yet wildly present.

The architectural approach extols the ecological integrity of the place, but also wanted to bring a new cultural dimension by providing an enhancement of the Malagasy identity codes. Culture and nature are thus the building blocks of the project.

Materials have been used in this very natural spirit. There is no color, no firework, only the material counts. The wood brings sensuality, the stone or polished concrete brings a mineral aspect.

For the décor, we valued local crafts reflecting an almost tribal aesthetic, simple and essential.

The challenge of this project was to organize the work during the rainy season with a very limited planning (4 months on site) and a logistics' complex approach

Aesthetics and passive operation.

Located at the end of the Madirokely beach, below a hill, this small rustic hotel wants to renovate and expand to become a chic and eco lodge.

The challenge of this project was to have all elements of the program on a land already densely occupied and to keep it open to the public during construction activity. For all new bungalows to have views over the sea and to respect the needs of privacy of a luxury accommodation, we have make use of the sea and the hill. Thus, the luxury bungalows in wood and polished concrete are located seafront and their terrace hang over the water. A large pool operates with seawater, with a drainage system and pumping concealed under the pontoon. The ecological challenge was met and now the hotel is certified by the label «Green Globe».

The municipal garden of Tulear is a very frequent space where the big public gatherings take place. The Botanical Garden is an educational attraction with the endemic plants of this region, the driest of Madagascar. The museum speaks about culture, tradition, minerals, shells, geology, musical instrument, reconstitution of a real-life prehistoric bird, but especially Mikea people. The Garden of the Sea was a major national project inaugurated in September 2017 by the President of the Republic of Madagascar.

This site got botanical interest for its majestic Baobabs and with historical military interest dating from the time of the colony. The reception and service buildings are cubic forms with local white stone cladding cut into small square blocks with a tight layout with dry edges. The site is mineral. It is proposed a walk in an educational botanical garden with endemic specimens. The Baobab is emblematic of the site. Only with a guide, it is possible to do a sporting trekking to reach the former military camp at the top of the mountain of the French. Signposting and accessibility are provided as well as rest areas, panoramic viewpoints, the development of the old tunnel with 747 steps equivalent to 40 floors. In the first year of operation, the site made 9,000 visitors, ie 9 times more than the previous year.


National Parks of Madagascar are magnificent sites but unfortunately with bad access infrastructures: Investments have been stalled until accessibility improves.

National Parks have a primary interest in the conservation of protected species such as sea Turtles and rare Manatee in the Nosy Hara archipelago with 17 islands with very specific Tsingy geology.

For Tsimanampetsotsa the interest is paleontological with major discoveries that have interested all specialized scientists of the whole world. Bones of several extinct and unknown species were piled up at the bottom of an underwater cave. Bones of giant lemurs, dwarf hippopotamuses, horned crocodiles have been discovered by experts of extreme sport Cave Diving: underwater speleology in meanders of corridors and cellars of white clay, totally unexplored and never reached by the light natural. The big clay lake is white like milk.



A Land-Art post-industrial experience.

The purpose of this project was to restore a former prestige to the park of this recently renovated family castle. The sugar industry, to which this colonial building was attached, has ceased its activity and only a few vestiges are still visible: wall and stone fireplace, railroad track, body of water, balance, stable...

The starting point of this project was inspired by a bronze sculpture of Nathalie Decoster that I glimpsed at a first visit on site. «Man facing the time» represents a messenger walking endlessly in a circular time connecting past and future. The integration of these traces of the past in a unique landscaped area was obvious.

An experimental bioclimatic technical solution was proposed for this National Work budget: 250 000 Eu- Tender. The unusual construction technique, offering unbeatable thermal and acoustic performance for a very low cost. Ecobeam truss structure with wood reinforced with bent tubes in galvanized tubes. The Ecobeam has solid performances capable of withstanding class V cyclones.

> The Superadobe is a technique of filling the walls with large bricks of raw earth in lost forms made of Gony (Polypropylene bag made in Madagascar from recycled plastic). The earth taken from the site was analyzed to give the formula. The bioclimatic principle of classrooms for:

- be acoustically insulated from the road,
- have maximized natural lighting thanks to precise studies on the orientation and position of the openings,
- have a thermal inertia thanks to the calculation of radiation on the roofs and facades
- make the most of natural ventilation for comfort performance,
- have very high fire safety performance.
























The site hosting the project is located in the middle of an old beachfront bungalow, on a family property subdivided by the progenies.

A home suitable to the needs and the lifestyle of its occupants. This villa of traditional style was built about fifteen years ago for a single man. Today, with a large family, the needs have evolved considerably. It was all about reviewing the whole functioning and the use of the existing spaces, and to create new spaces. A new entry, a living room, a kiosk and a space dedicated to the service (laundry, pantry, space for staff), were created. The refitting of the corridors, kitchen and day and night zones required heavy structural work on the roof, walls and floors. 




